

Inclement Weather Policy

Health and safety are of primary concern. Therefore, we encourage our older members especially to pray and worship at home rather than risk falling or being in an accident during inclement weather. All members are encouraged to exercise good common sense by dressing for warmth, comfort, and safety during wintry conditions.

We will continue our regular schedule as often as possible. However, when winter weather dictates, the staff (in consultation with the Deacon Chairman) will follow these guidelines for cancellations:

Sundays

The shuttle lot is not cleared on weekends, so shuttles will not run in bad weather.

1. When conditions are hazardous (it's snowing and/or streets are covered with significant amounts of snow and/or ice) and recognizing that church parking lots may not be completely clear, there will be no 8:15 a.m. service or Sunday Bible Study.
2. Normally, there will be a 10:45 a.m. worship service. However, this service may also be cancelled in extreme conditions.
3. Decisions regarding Sunday afternoon/evening activities will be announced on Sunday morning.

Sunday Afternoon/Evenings

1. If the Sunday morning worship services were cancelled, there will be **NO activities on Sunday afternoon/evening.**
2. **If road conditions become more hazardous during the day,** the decision to cancel Sunday afternoon activities will be made by 2:00 p.m.

Weekday Daytime

1. If Winston-Salem/Forsyth County schools are cancelled there will be **NO Preschool.**
2. **The only activities will be those for Adults. However, when road conditions are hazardous,** the decision to cancel these activities will be made with enough time to contact the members of the group.

Weekday Evenings

1. If school is cancelled there will be **NO Children/Youth activities, NO childcare.**
2. **The only activities will be those for Adults, including Music Rehearsals (with no childcare provided). However, when road conditions are hazardous,** the decision to cancel these activities will be made by 5:00 p.m.
